

New curriculum: The essentials of subject leadership in primary schools



A one-day course for teachers new to subject leadership or those wishing to refresh their skills – including headteachers and NQTs.

This course will support newly appointed subject leaders in school, and also act as a refresher for those already in post. It will cover the skills and documentation necessary to fulfil the role of subject leader at this crucial time when school curriculums are being developed.

NB This course is not intended to be subject-specific but rather to cover generic skills applicable to any subject.

This course aims to provide practical and clear guidance on areas such as:

- exploring the essential functions of subject leadership in the light of the new national curriculum
- considering how to monitor and what to evaluate
- deciding how much to record, and how little to keep, as evidence of effectiveness of the role
- discussing effective audits and action plans. Is this subject fit and healthy?
- exploring how to lead and deliver effective CPD for others.
