In order to support Designated Teachers for Looked After Children in their statutory role, the Virtual School is offering a half day's training course.

Objectives and Outcomes:

- Have an understanding of the legal context and statutory guidance.
- Be familiar with the latest changes to pupil premium funding, know how to access it and be aware of ways to maximize its use to boost attainment.
- Be aware of the educational disadvantage faced by children in public care and understand the need for positive systems of support to overcome them.
- Be aware of the possible obstacles to achievement and consider the importance of enabling and supporting success.
- Have considered how to establish an environment and ethos which encourages looked after children to value education and succeed.
- Have an understanding of how to support children and young people in education and help them to access appropriate educational opportunities both in and out of school.
