A plan to convert Statements of SEN into Education, Health and Care Plans

- All Statements of SEN must be converted to Education, Health and Care (EHC) Plans by April 2018.
- There are currently approximately 4,500 pupils with Statements of SEN.

However, EHC Coordinators may convert some Statements of SEN to an EHC Plan earlier than this timetable suggests, with the agreement of the family.

Students with Learning Difficulty Assessments:

Until 1 September 2016, we will continue to implement the sections of the current Learning Difficulty Assessment statutory guidance in relation to young people who receive support in post-16 education and training as a result of an LDA and ensure that it continues to meet the needs of the young person.

An EHC Plan should be in place by 1 September 2016 for young people in further education and training who receive provision as a result of a LDA if they are continuing in further education or training beyond that date. We will be carrying out detailed analysis to find out which young people will be remaining in further education and training so we can prioritise their transition from LDA to an EHC Plan.
