**Re: Allocation of Review and Development Advisers 2003/2004**

I am writing to inform you that it has become necessary to review the allocation of Review and Development Advisers (RDAs) to schools for 2003/2004. The reason for this is staff leaving the service or moving on to other roles within the LEA and the resultant "knock on" effects this has. These circumstances are beyond our control and are the results of colleagues retiring or going to new posts as part of their career development. I am sorry if this causes any inconvenience but I assure you that the quality of the RDA service to schools will not be affected.

In addition for the 2003/2004 academic year I am allocating for the first time a second named RDA for all Secondary and Special Schools. The reason for this is to provide an enhanced service so that cover is immediately available if the first named RDA is unavailable for any reason. Also there are times when circumstances require an input from more than one member of the Advisory Service. By identifying the second RDA for each school, continuity and speed of response is guaranteed. However, the first named RDA is still your key point of contact.

As from September 2003 your main contact RDA and support RDA will be:

The letter was to be sent out at an earlier date, however, changes announced by the DfES in August relating to target setting has meant that procedures and guidance have had to be revised and rewritten.
