FREE is a ground-breaking Stonewall film for primary school pupils, from Rikki Beadle-Blair, that conveys a powerful message about difference, diversity and respect. The 60-minute film follows the stories of four children as they explore family, friendship and what it means to be yourself. **FREE** challenges homophobic bullying and language and shows the importance of celebrating difference. It has been specifically designed to complement schools' KS2 PSHE curriculum. The screening will be followed by a Q & A session with the director.
