Teaching and Learning

Health & Safety management for Heads of D&T



This course is designed for the Head of Department or Second in Department in D&T and those aspiring to such a role. The main emphasis is on management issues, risk assessment and the monitoring of H&S. Technicians may also find this course useful.

The course involves a mixture of presenter input, discussion and exercises. The focus will be on reducing to a minimum the chances of accidents involving staff and students.

During the course the following items will be covered:

- The law and health and safety. What the law requires employers, teachers, technician and heads of department to do.
- Basic principles relating to H&S.
- Health and safety regulations and how they affect D&T.
- Requirements for D&T rooms and workshop machines in respect of health and safety.
- Organising and managing risk assessment in design and technology, including the modification of model risk assessments.
- Use and maintenance of local exhaust ventilation
- Aspects of using and guarding machines in common use.
- Ample opportunities for participants to raise questions about their own concerns.

Participants who attend the whole course will receive a CLEAPSS Certificate of Attendance.
