This call out is a chance for those young people to exhibit a rich and beautiful range of work which will celebrate the purist and sometimes most personal of art forms.

THE EVENT

The Young Norfolk Arts Festival is therefore hosting an exhibition of drawings by young artists from **year groups 9 to 11** in the beautiful and inspiring surroundings of the **Norwich Cathedral Hostry**. The exhibition will be open to the public from **3rd to 17th July**. There will be a private view for the artists and their families and teachers on 2nd July.

THE INVITATION

Artists in those year groups are invited with their teachers to attend a special free workshop at the Norwich Castle Museum on **Wednesday 15th April**. At the moment places are limited to **3 artists per school**. Artists will be supplied with all necessary drawing materials and guidance will be on hand from Ian Passam, Head of Norwich School Art and Design, artists Gerard Stamp and Paul Fenner and graduates in art and design. The workshop will last from 10am to 2pm with a break for lunch. The Castle's picnic area will be available.

All drawings for the exhibition will be collected on that day and framed by YNAF ready for hanging.
