*Mastering Mathematics -
teaching to transform achievement*

This will be the fourth cross-phase conference held in Norfolk, building on the success of the three previous conferences. It is a unique opportunity for delegates to hear from a national keynote speaker on mathematics education, to meet a wide range of publishers and to experience a variety of workshops covering the teaching and learning of mathematics in all phases from EYFS to KS4.

This year's keynote speaker is Dr Helen Drury, Director of Mathematics Mastery. Previously, Director of Mathematics for ARK Schools, responsible for leading the development and introduction of the mastery curriculum. She was also one of the four members of the group involved in the draft for the 2014 national curriculum for mathematics.



Helen will share her knowledge and expertise on improving and developing mathematics teaching and learning in schools.

All workshops will be hands-on and focused on improving teaching and learning in the classroom. They will be led by practitioners from teaching schools, MaST teachers, leading teachers, subject experts and mathematics advisers.
