We are looking for anyone interested in becoming a host family for a Spanish PE teacher attending a four-week training programme run by Minority Achievement and Attainment Service, part of Norfolk Integrated Advisory Service, based at the Professional Development Centre, 144 Woodside Road, Norwich, NR7 9QL from Saturday 27th June 2014 to Saturday 25th July 2015

Due to the location of the training venue, host families must live in Norwich.

This would be an exciting opportunity to find out more about another culture and to show the warmth of Norfolk hospitality!

Expectations of Host Families:

Host families will be paid £520 for the four week stay to provide half board accommodation which will include:

- A single study bedroom which will have a bed with a good supply of bedding, ample drawer and hanging space, a mirror, adequate lighting and a writing desk or table. Hosts will provide and launder bed linen and hand and bath towels.
- Breakfast and evening meals each day.
- Adequate access to bathroom facilities and can have a daily shower or bath.

The teachers are here as 'paying guests'. They are paying for the privilege of becoming an additional member of the family and should be treated as such. They will be expected to assimilate into English family life. A programme of activities will be arranged for the teachers on 2 of the Saturdays in July.
