Course aimed at: adults working with pupils with dyslexia between the ages of 5 and 18

Course Content:

- · what dyslexia means
- · how memory affects learning
- · why oral skills are important
- · What issues are faced by learners with dyslexia when learning to read, spell and write
- · how dyslexia may affect the development of numeracy skills
- · what role assistive technology can play
- · what assessments are available and how they might be used
- · many different strategies for addressing the barriers to learning that people with dyslexia may face

Course Fee: This course has been organised and hosted by the Aylsham Cluster Trust, schools within this cluster will pay reduced fees of £100 per person. The course is also open to participants outside of the cluster at the standard course price of:
