The independent support service provides free advice and support for parents of children with special educational needs and disability, and young people with special educational needs and disability, through the statutory assessment Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) processes.

Our independent supporters will offer a range of time limited support such as liaison across different agencies and the level and nature of that support will be tailored to your particular needs.



What we do:

- Give information to parents and young people so they are empowered to make the right decisions when going through the EHCP assessment.
- The level and nature of our support will be tailored to your particular needs.
- Give you the flexibility to opt in or out of our service at any time during the 20 week EHCP process.
- Signpost you to different agencies within the local offer.
- We liaise across different agencies to ensure support is tailored to your needs.
