This performance is offered as part of a creative workshop day at The Garage, Norwich, during which young people from 3 local schools will work around the carousel of workshops including playtime on the set with the company and two other sessions linked to themes from the show. **Performance and workshop package costs just £250 per group** (maximum 30 students)

We will provide a comprehensive and easy to use learning resource pack to support the show which includes the following curriculum links:

- Develop literacy skills by harnessing motivation and inspiration through writing activities, group work and reading aloud.
- PSHE & Citizenship – importance of individuality, acceptance and tolerance, social cohesion and self expression.
- Physical Education – using bodies, simple choreography, physical group work.
