Did you know that 3% of children have experienced the death of a sibling or parent? This training event is designed for all staff who work with children in schools. It is free to all LA Schools and those schools/academies, which are subscribing to the CI Service.

Children who are bereaved, often turn to adults they have a trusting relationship with, and within schools this can include their Class Teachers, Teaching Assistants. Midday Instructors, Supervisors, Administrative and other staff. Parents often talk to the School Secretary or the Parent Supporter in the school. The full-day course will offer the opportunity to try out some activities that can be undertaken with children, as well as some ideas for teaching death and bereavement in the curriculum.
