Teaching Assistants in the primary phase: *developing positive attitudes to learning in small groups*



Develop attitudes to learning that promote progress in small group settings.

This half-day course will explore and develop effective approaches to promoting positive attitudes to learning, and hence progress, when working with small groups. How this links to current Ofsted requirements will be examined, with a particular focus on the links between quality of teaching and pupils' attitudes to learning. Emphasis will be on how to empower pupils to be learners and for them to develop articulacy around the learning they are doing. Methods for monitoring the effectiveness and impact of these approaches will also be explored.

By the end of the session delegates will:

- understand current Ofsted requirements in regard to quality of teaching and attitudes to learning
- fully understand the links between behaviours for learning (attitudes to learning) and pupil progress
- empower pupils to understand and have ownership of their behaviour as a learner.
- develop methods to monitor the effectiveness and impact of approaches to developing behaviours for learning.
