What would I do as a member of the editorial team?

The editorial team is made up of young journalists and photographers – aged 13-18.

The team meet once per month at the EDP offices to plan what will go in each edition of Future Voices. In between meetings you will write and edit the articles.

The photographers will be responsible for capturing the right image to go with each article.

Together you will plan, write and edit 12 editions of Future Voices over the course of a year. All the completed articles and photos will appear on the EDP website, and many will also be printed in the paper.

Photography

During the course of the project there may be opportunities to publicise some of the activities that the young people are involved in. This may well involve filming or photographing young people for use in the local media and social media; we welcome these opportunities and hope that you do too. There may also be occasions when we arrange photography for our own purposes, such as displays, our website and publicity brochures.

Photography or filming will only take place with the **permission** of each young person's Youth Worker and under their supervision. Young people will only be named if there is a particular reason to do so (e.g. they have completed a specific activity or achieved an award). Home addresses or contact details will never be given out.

I understand that images may be taken of the above named young person as follows:

- By the local media in covering programme activities that show the programme and young people in a positive light (participating in activities, sports, prize-givings, etc).
- By photographers acting on behalf of the programme for use in displays and publicity material. (Images will be used for a maximum of 2 years and will then be destroyed.)
