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What is a Licensed Tutor?

A Tutor is a teacher who has successfully completed an Unlocking the World [Tutor Training Program](#). A Tutor receives a licence that allows them to deliver the corresponding [Teacher Development Course](#) within their school on a non-commercial basis and to purchase Course manuals. There is no limit to the number of Teacher Development Courses a Tutor can deliver.

The course is for experienced EAL practitioners and teachers who have successfully completed the TESMC lilac course and developed their practice over a significant period of time.

What is a Tutor Training Program?

Unlocking the World Tutor Training Programs are intensive 3 - 5 consecutive day train-the-trainer professional development programs for experienced teachers delivered in host schools around the world.
