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What is a Licensed Tutor?

A Tutor is a teacher who has successfully completed an Unlocking the World <u>Tutor Training Program</u>. A Tutor receives a licence that allows them to deliver the corresponding <u>Teacher Development Course</u> within their school on a non-commercial basis and to purchase Course manuals. There is no limit to the number of Teacher Development Courses a Tutor can deliver.

The course is for experienced EAL practitioners and teachers who have successfully completed the TESMC lilac course and developed their practice over a significant period of time.

What is a Tutor Training Program?
