Cafés are proving to make a significant contribution to school improvement by helping raise achievement, create reading and learning cultures, engage with stakeholders, widen participation and strengthen the home/school relationship. This course equips class teachers, Teaching Assistants and Parent Support Advisers to run successful Café sessions from Foundation Stage to Year 6. The training consistently receives very positive evaluations from delegates.

Following this course, delegates will:

- have a secure understanding of Norfolk's Café programme and the Café concept and rationale
- know how to implement the Café programme in their own school so that all families can benefit
- be able to plan and deliver a variety of family learning opportunities in Café sessions
- understand how to help all parents and families support and develop a child's learning across the curriculum
- have begun action planning for the introduction of Cafés, with a secure understanding of how to evaluate impact on pupil and adult outcomes as well as aspects of school improvement.
