

Improving English Programme for Secondary Teachers



A three-day programme for secondary teachers seeking to improve their practice in the teaching of English.

This programme will develop subject knowledge, skills and pedagogy of those seeking to improve their practice in the planning, assessment and teaching of reading, writing, speaking and listening. It will focus on the revised curriculum and new examination specifications.

Each session has a particular teaching and learning focus and is designed to allow participants to improve their own classroom practice.

Course objectives

- Gain a solid understanding of the nature of English as currently manifested in the revised curriculum
- Develop and deepen understanding of key aspects of good English teaching and learning, and the subject knowledge which underpins this
- Influence classroom practice, through exposure to practical ideas to challenge and engage pupils.

The programme works best if schools are able to send teachers out in pairs or threes, to better support application back in school (including the specific school-based gap tasks). However, it is still viable if a school cannot release teachers at the same time, as it is possible to create a triad across different schools, or nominate a learning partner back in school.

Particularly useful for NQTs, returners to teaching, non-specialists and teachers who need their skills refreshing.
