

Teaching gymnastics in an inclusive curriculum:

This course ensures compliance with local and national best practice and explores the effective, teaching of inclusive, high quality gymnastics to all pupils – not just the more able.

After initial discussion and self-evaluation of provision, including re-emphasising county and national safety guidance, we will explore how to develop progressive teaching rooted in pedagogy which ensures all learners, regardless of ability are challenged.

We will look at:

- effective strategies for assessment of progress
- safe handling of apparatus
- effective use of apparatus, including mats: introducing it and engaging with it effectively to reduce queuing and maximise learning
- effective use of time; engaging pupils in more intense, vigorous activity
- embedding Ofsted best practice.
