Invitation to West Norfolk Specialist Academy Drop in Session - Monday 14 September 2015

Norfolk will benefit from nearly 100 additional places for children with special educational needs thanks to plans for a new specialist academy in King's Lynn. The school will cater for children and young people with behaviour, emotional and social difficulties at Bryggen Road on the North Lynn Industrial Estate.

The new all-through school will provide day provision for 96 boys and girls aged between 4 and 16, with 56 places for primary school children and 40 secondary places. The new places at the school will help ease the current shortfall in the county for children with special educational needs, and will be a vital part of Norfolk's Local Offer of support to these children and young people.
