# Improving **Secondary** EAL Provision – *admissions and induction*



**Ensure schools have the necessary systems in place and resources available for the effective admission of EAL pupils.**

Delegates will be shown EAL resources available for admission and induction for the Secondary phase. Systems and resources will be discussed and evaluated.

Each delegate will also be offered a FREE EAL follow up visit or school training by an EAL Adviser as part of the cost of the course to ensure impact and effective staff development.

## **EAL - The Department of Education definition**

*A pupil's first language is defined as **any language other than English that a child was exposed to during early development and continues to be exposed to in the home or community.** If a child was exposed to more than one language (which may include English) during early development, a language other than English should be recorded, **irrespective of the child's proficiency in English.***
