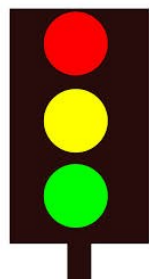


Expected prior knowledge

Is this course for me?

This course is for you if you

- are interested in dyslexia and want to further your understanding of dyslexia
- work with pupils with dyslexia between the ages of 5 and 18
- want to remove the barriers that dyslexia may create in a word based society

Certification

The qualification will be awarded based on activities completed during the sessions.

Content

You will learn

- what dyslexia means
- how memory affects learning
- why oral skills are important
- What issues are faced by learners with dyslexia when learning to read, spell and write
- how dyslexia may affect the development of numeracy skills
- what role assistive technology can play
- what assessments are available and how they might be used
- many different strategies for addressing the barriers to learning that people with dyslexia may face
