WHY TEACH MINIMUS LATIN?

- Included in the list of languages for KS2, but does not require a specialist language teacher
- Funding is available to assist with the purchase of resources
- Introduces children to the concept of "language" and helps them to become effective language learners
- Supports Literacy (grammar, spelling, punctuation, word derivations)
- Supports MFL and can be incorporated across the curriculum
- Based on the lives of a real family and on artefacts found at the fort of Vindolanda
- Presented through colourful comic strips which focus on different parts of speech
