Eco-Schools: an environmentally friendly way forward for your school



We will explore how the Eco-Schools framework can provide a motivating context for the active participation of children and young people, and help your school reduce its ecological footprint.

We will consider what an Eco-School could look like; have a go at some activities that can be used with pupils to explore sustainability; evaluate skills pupils require for a sustainable future; attempt Holt Hall's Eco-Trail and guide participants through the most important aspects of the Eco-Schools Framework. We will use a variety of teaching approaches throughout the day (including some outdoors) and draw the day to a close after a thorough plenary session which includes planning for action on return to school.

By the end of the course participants will go away having:

- an understanding of the Eco-Schools process
- ideas about how their school could tread more lightly on the earth
- examples of some related activities that are suitable for children and young people
- a plan of 'where to go next' on return to school
- enjoyed exploring the grounds of Holt Hall Environmental and Outdoor Learning Centre with like-minded colleagues on a day that has been good for well-being.
