The main objective of this programme is the early exposure to foreign languages. Children learning additional languages build stronger multi-tasking skills, delay dementia, improve their memory and decision-making skills, become more perceptive and improve their English grammar, conjugations and sentence structure. Also children who study foreign languages tend to score better on standardised tests than their monolingual peers, particularly in maths, reading and vocabulary.

- learn basic Spanish from a variety of authentic sources
- explore Spanish resources (videos, songs, rhymes) for classroom use
- twin up with a school from Spain using e-twinning.
