Led by trained educators all our activities are high quality, fun, interactive environmental education visits to your school. Our trained educators can deliver the following sessions, at no cost to you. **Choose a visit from:**

Give Nature a Home – Find out all about the habitats in your school, what already exists and where the opportunities are to create more. Designed to help your pupils map and score your school grounds for nature.

Bioblitz –What’s living in your school grounds? We’ll help your pupils hunt for plants and minibeasts under every rock, bush and doormat. You may be surprised by what you find!

Big Schools’ Birdwatch – using ID guides and binoculars, your pupils will identify and record the birds we spot around the school. PLEASE NOTE: this activity is only available during the first half-term after Christmas. The Big Schools’ Birdwatch is the school version of the Big Garden Birdwatch – the world’s biggest garden wildlife survey aimed at families and individuals.

All of our visits have been carefully designed to meet learning outcomes from the National Curriculum for Science and can be geared towards KS1 or KS2. There are many follow up activities where you can use results from the visits to complete learning outcomes for other curriculum areas, for example in numeracy.

The visits support the emphasis on a broad curriculum, in the new Common Inspection Framework, helping your school towards delivering a varied and exciting curriculum for your pupils. Each visit lasts 90 minutes.

This offer is currently limited to primary schools in Norwich and the Broads area.

The visits can also be counted towards your Eco Schools Award.
