What is CCET?

The Certificate of Competence in Educational Testing (CCET) will enable the participant to confidently understand the principles involved in educational testing and carry out that testing themselves.

A successful completion of the CCET will lead to the British Psychological Society Test User Educational qualification *(additional registration fee & annual subscription to BPS is not included in the course fees).*

If desired, completion of the CCET will enable the participant to undertake the additional Access Arrangements Course (AAC) to become a Specialist Assessor as defined by JCQ regulations.

- understand the legislative and policy framework
