Are you looking for a fun, easy activity that engages your class with nature and fits with the national curriculum?

Registration has opened for the **RSPB Big Schools Birdwatch**, from 4 January to 12 February 2016. It takes just one hour, and teachers can pick any day during the first half of spring term to take part.

A record breaking 90,000 pupils and teachers took part in the survey last year by counting the feathered friends that visit their grounds. All the information collected by schools helps to track bird numbers, providing an insight into which species are doing well and those that need our help.

It works across a wide age and ability range and there's plenty of flexibility to run it as simply as you like either as the centrepiece of cross-curricular studies, project work, or as a way to improve your school grounds.
