

# An introduction to programming using Kodu



*Kodu is a free visual programming language made specifically for creating games. It is designed to be accessible for children and can be enjoyable for anyone creating games.*

This course is for teachers with little or no knowledge of Kodu. It will develop the delegate's programming skills in using the software to help meet the needs of the primary computing curriculum.

This full day hands on workshop will offer teachers practical ways of using Kodu to introduce simple programming to Key Stage 2 pupils. Kodu is a freely available visual programming language made specifically for creating games.

- enable participants to build 3D worlds
- introduce the key elements of games design
- provide a rich range of game play examples
- provide examples of how Kodu Game Lab has been used in schools
- give plenty of hands on time so that participants are confident in using Kodu Game Lab.
