

Assessment and monitoring in the EYFS: *what do I need to do?*



A practical course where good practice in monitoring and assessing children throughout the EYFS will be explored.



This will be a practical course looking at a variety of evidence for assessment (provided by the delegates), including learning journeys. Discussion will be held around provision, the assessment/planning cycle, providing opportunities for, and deciding on, next steps in learning and end-of-year assessment for the EYFS profile.

Delegates must bring a copy of *Development Matters*, *The EYFS Profile Handbook* and three learning journeys of children with varying levels of development.

- Have a clear picture of methods of collecting and presenting 'on entry' data
- understand what assessment looks like throughout the Reception year
- understand how to interpret the data collected throughout the year and use it effectively to plan for progression
- understand the EYFS Profile and how to complete it
- gain a clear picture of good assessment practice in the EYFS.
