

Raising Reading Standards at KS2



A package of collaborative CPD designed to promote:

- Sustainable improvement in an area of reading, to benefit a specific group of pupils;
- The sharing of good reading practice across schools;
- The development of new 'out of cluster' collaboration between schools.

This adviser facilitated programme is designed to respond to the individual needs of each school, to raise standards in reading. Through exploring and sharing best practice in reading provision across the curriculum, participating schools will be enabled to plan and implement reading improvement actions in response their specific requirements, and be equipped to produce a short case study evidencing the impact of the focus.

Cost includes 3 full days of training, plus a twilight.

There will also need to be a commitment from each school to provide the Subject Leader attending with 2 days of additional cover, to carry out tasks, liaise with other schools and write a case study exploring impact.
