Singing in School

Getting started and making progress

Course Description

A 3 day course for all school staff to improve singing in their school. The course is led by Apollo 5. Apollo5 (part of Voces Cantabiles Music) work in partnership with Music Hubs, schools and other educational organisations involving more than 25,000 young people each year

No music reading is necessary and Apollo 5 will be working with children for part of each day.

Course Outcomes

Each day we will be with 5 members of Apollo who will focus on the following

- Ways to improve the quality of sound from warm ups to vocal technique
- Ideas and repertoire for teaching in class
- Hand-outs for you to follow back in school between sessions

Please be prepared for your school to commit to all 3 days of the course which are as follows
