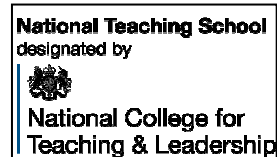


SHERINGHAM PRIMARY NATIONAL TEACHING SCHOOL

LEADING TEACHER SUPPORT PROGRAMME



This programme is designed to support teachers working in the tier just below the Headteacher and covers some of the areas in the Headteacher Support Programme as well as other areas for school improvement which are relevant for leading teachers. The programme forms part of the Norfolk Leadership Pathway and any aspiring Headteacher would benefit greatly from participating in this CPD opportunity.

LTSP will be delivered in a range of schools across Norfolk by Headteachers and Deputy & Assistant Headteachers. You will work with colleagues, discussing issues and undertaking activities that will support your professional development and help you to work with your Headteacher and staff to improve your schools. LTSP is for infant, junior or primary teachers in all schools. The programme will run on seven days throughout the Spring & Summer Terms. On completion of the programme you will have the opportunity to do a placement in another school. Also, be part of the secondment back

Day 3 - 13th April	Fairstead Primary, Kings Lynn	- Learning policies, book scrutinies & curriculum planning.
Day 4 - 27th April	Sheringham Primary School	- Lesson observations, learning walks
Day 5 - 18th May	St Mary's and St Peter's Primary, Great Yarmouth	- Raise online, Flying start, Key data
Day 6 - 15th June	Litcham School	- Moderation, Standardisation, Safeguarding
Day 7 - 29th June	St Nicholas Priory Junior, Great Yarmouth	- Performance management, pupil progress meetings, planning staff development.
