10 ways Google Classroom can make learning better



Google Classroom contains online tools, freely available to all schools, which teachers can use to improve learning.


This course is suitable for all schools who use Norfolk NSIX email accounts, or schools who already have their own Google Apps for Education domain. Google Apps for Education is available free to all schools.

Current educational research tells us that one of the most effective things we can do to help students learn better is to tighten up the feedback cycle, giving them faster and more timely comment and critique on their work. A key focus during this course will be how Google Classroom can enable teachers to focus on feedback and create opportunities for dialogue between teacher and student in a safe online environment.

Delegates will learn, through hands on experience, how to use the tools within Google Classroom effectively to enable better learning outcomes for all students through better assessment for learning opportunities. This session will provide teachers with ideas, techniques and tools for improving student progress by providing better, faster and more effective feedback.
