- recognised a range of experiences related to loss and bereavement
- increased their awareness of the issues faced by children and young people experiencing a bereavement
- gained in confidence in working with children, young people, their parents and carers during their bereavement
- identified resources and organisations available to support bereaved families
- taken part in a therapeutic activity used with bereaved children and adults

Training is suitable for professionals working with children and young people e.g. teachers, social workers and pastoral care workers.
