Promoting and developing SMSC – culture, ethos and meeting statutory duties.

Every school must have regard to the promotion and development of SMSC and understand how this contributes to pupil outcomes. Ofsted will evaluate how a school's culture promotes SMSC development and in particular how it supports wider aspects such as keeping pupils safe. Ensure that there is a shared understanding amongst all staff of their role in promoting and developing SMSC.

Delegates will unpick and explore what is the purpose of promoting SMSC development and why this must sit at the heart of school ethos. How SMSC development supports meeting the statutory 'Prevent Duty' will be an important element of this training. Alongside this, there will be a look at how SMSC supports British values and the need to prepare learners for life in modern Britain. There will be opportunity to review tools for auditing current provision for SMSC as well as examining effective policy and practice. There will be an emphasis on the need for a broad and balanced curriculum as well as having a sound understanding of how the culture of a school fully supports all aspects of SMSC promotion and development.
