What is a School Profile?

A School Profile is a report created from health data relating to a school population, presented in an aggregated non-identifiable format

What is it for?

The profile can be used as a resource to provide information and insight about health and social factors affecting your school population, to assist with

- Guidance on the training required for staff members to help them support the health needs of the school population
- Providing insight into health issues affecting your school population to inform potential educational initiatives relating to health matters

What information?

This might include information on the incidence of allergies, certain health conditions, ongoing medication or health related social factors in the school population

What it is NOT for

It is NOT to identify health issues or factors affecting individual pupils - any information that could lead to identification by association would automatically be excluded

What is the purpose of this Focus Group?

The purpose of this Focus Group is to get a stronger idea of what data or information should be available in a school profile - What factors are you interested in? How would you like the report to appear?
