Fully funded through the Healthy Early Years programme A half day workshop to help early years practitioners extend the physical activity opportunities available to the under fives in their care. The workshop will consist of a mixture of some formal theory and interactive group based tasks with time allowed for discussion, feedback and questions. There will also be a practical session (1 hour) which enables participants to experience how the early years physical guidelines translate into practice in the early years setting. The course is especially suited to those who would like to learn more about the importance of physical activity in the early years and how to engage babies and young children in more physically active play.
