

Teaching Assessment 2016: Using the Interim teacher assessment framework for maths KS1

Summer 2016 will see year 2 children to be assessed against the new national curriculum for the first time. Following the removal of levels, teachers must make robust and accurate judgements for pupils' mathematics using the new 2016 interim teacher assessment framework for KS1.

This two half-day course will support teachers to develop a collective understanding of the interim assessment framework in relation to children's work from their own setting, giving them the confidence that they will be submitting accurate teacher judgements.

Day 1 Delegates will have the opportunity to explore and unpick through professional discussion led by a subject specialist, the interim assessment maths framework. They will align what is assessed with what is taught from the national curriculum, looking specifically at number sense, place value and calculation fluency.

Delegates will need to bring a collection of mathematics evidence for the second session. Further details will be provided on Day 1.

Day 2 Using collections of children's work from their own settings, delegates will be supported to work collaboratively to apply the interim assessment framework and make assessments of children's work. With plenty of opportunities for discussion, delegates will then benefit from the chance to compare their judgements and develop a collective understanding.
