Norfolk Mathematics Conference 2016 *Making Numbers*

This conference is a unique opportunity for delegates to hear from a national keynote speaker on mathematics education, to meet a wide range of publishers and to experience a variety of workshops covering the teaching and learning of mathematics in all phases from EYFS to KS4.



This year's keynote speaker is Dr Sue Gifford. Sue is a Principal Lecturer in mathematics education at the University of Roehampton. She previously worked in London schools as a primary teacher and mathematics consultant. She has published and contributed to books and articles on primary and early years maths education and more recently on dyscalculia and mathematics difficulties.

Sue will share her current two-year research and development project 'Making Numbers' which is funded by the Nuffield Foundation. The aim is to support teachers in using 'manipulatives' to help children learn about numbers and arithmetic in engaging and meaningful ways.

All workshops will be hands-on and focused on improving teaching and learning in the classroom. They will be led by subject experts, MaST teachers, practitioners from teaching schools, leading teachers and mathematics consultants.
