The Forestry Commission is developing an exciting Heritage Lottery funded project 'Trailing the Hidden Heritage of High Lodge', creating a new, all-ability, multi-user trail into the heart of Thetford Forest, exploring archaeology, history, wildlife and trees.

Your school is invited to enter a competition to

DESIGN A SHELTER which could be built on the Trail.

Footprint size: 2400mm x 1200mm

It needs to:

- include wood in its construction
- be weatherproof
- low maintenance
- have wall space and seating
- be suitable for adults and children
- have space for pushchairs and wheelchairs.

It will be judged on creativity, innovation and the use of materials. Please remember to keep the design practical and sympathetic to the Forest environment.

Entries can be in any form, but must be submitted at the school's cost. No items will be returned at the end of the competition.

Each entry must be clearly marked with the name of the school and give a named contact (no restriction on entries per school).

The competition closes on 30 June 2016. Winners will be notified by the end of the summer term.

One winning primary school and one winning secondary school will receive 2 'Coach' Discovery Passes worth £300. The passes will allow unlimited visits to High Lodge between July 2016 and June 2017 for each coach.
