## RESEARCH EXPERTISE AND INTERESTS

The EdD is delivered by a team of highly qualified and experienced academic staff. We invite applications on research themes that are among the research expertise of the School, such as Literacy and Development, Mathematics Education, Cultural Studies in Education, Physical Education Pedagogy, and Higher Education and Society.

## PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The EdD is a part-time course in which students are able to conduct their own programme of research over five years. In years one and two students attend teaching sessions in educational theory and research methods in the form of four weekend study blocks and design their research project which they carry out in years' three, four and five. All EdD students work with a supervisory team who will support them throughout their studies.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Candidates will normally be expected to have a relevant Masters degree preferably with research component or other experience of research in Social Sciences. It is also expected that applicants will have some years experience in a relevant professional area.
