# 10 Ways Google Classroom can make learning better



Google Classroom contains online tools, freely available to all schools, which teachers can use to improve learning.

## **Course Outline**

Google Apps for Education is available free to all schools. Current educational research tells us that one of the most effective things we can do to help students learn better is to tighten up the feedback cycle, giving them faster and more timely comment and critique on their work.

A key focus during this course will be how Google Classroom can enable teachers to focus on feedback and create opportunities for dialogue between teacher and student in a safe online environment.

## By the end of the course participants will:-

- understand the key functionality of Google Classroom and how to use these tools within their own classroom and school
- apply this knowledge to provide efficient and effective feedback to students on an individual basis, enabling better assessment for learning opportunities
- use Google Classroom to create workflow between student and teacher, where teachers have full visibility and access to student work.
