This one day course will focus on assessment being the foundation of learning and teaching. Crucially focussing on the relationship assessment has with mastery, day to day teaching, continuity and progression of pupils.

By the end of the course participants will:-

- have a clear understanding of assessment without levels in PE
- know how the new assessment policy should support improved progress, standards and inclusiveness in PE lessons for pupils
- know how the new assessment policy should lead to less administration for teachers.
