The DfE has renewed the Collective Worship licences held by schools in your authority.

[CCLI](#) provides licences to schools to cover the reproduction of hymns and worship songs for use in Collective Worship/assemblies.

We are pleased to confirm that the Department for Education has renewed these licences until April 2017 under its [national licence arrangements](#).

Who does this apply to?

This applies to maintained schools in England and covers primary and secondary schools (including academies) and special schools and pupil referral units. Nursery schools and Independent schools are not included.

How does the arrangement work?

Each individual school remains the licensee and as such is responsible for ensuring that the licence Terms of Agreement are adhered to. Licence certificates and associated information can be downloaded from [CCLI's website](#).
