Introducing improvements for our customers

Our HR Services team has been developing a new on-line system for customers to use to notify them of new starters, changes to contracts, leavers and changes to personal details. The system has been through internal testing and initial user testing with a group of schools. The live system is currently being piloted in a group of schools with a wider roll-out planned for September subject to a successful pilot.

HR Services are also working on a number of other service improvements, the most significant being preparation for a rebuild of Schools PeopleNet. Some customer feedback has already been obtained and a survey is now being undertaken with a sample of governors, headteachers, school business managers and school administrators, prior to finalising the requirement specification for the new site. More information will follow as this project moves forward through the autumn term.
