

Mathematics Toolkit: The Story Behind the KS2 National Curriculum Tests 2016 (whole school event)

The aim of the new curriculum was to raise the standard of mathematics and make sure pupils were ready for secondary mathematics. As a result many schools received results that they were not expecting. This course will aid you in your understanding of the new tests and the expectations they place on the teaching of mathematics at Key Stage 2.

Course Outline

This course will forensically examine the KS2 National Curriculum Tests (2016) by critiquing questions, looking at and considering the balance of curriculum content and offering specific feedback about areas that need further attention before next school year so you can plan your teaching.

- have a clear understanding of the requirements for the KS2 national curriculum tests
- have a range of strategies to put in place with immediate effect to improve the teaching and learning of mathematics at KS2.
