FOLLOW-UP SESSIONS for the New Requirements within the schools' census - English language Proficiency

- Ensure schools have the necessary systems in place to capture contextual information about EAL pupils
- Offer additional further support to schools to help them improve EAL achievement
- Offer guidance in best practice for effectively monitoring EAL pupil progress.
