Maximising the impact of TAs

Investing in promoting the effective practice of Teaching Assistants is fundamental to school improvement.

Course Outline

This course focuses on the role of senior leaders in ensuring their TAs are well-equipped to be as effective as possible and thereby adding value in the school. It will examine how the preparedness, deployment and practice of TAs influences efficiency 'on the ground' and will use practical approaches to review current practice and identify areas for development. Through discussion and sharing effective practice, delegates will identify strategies to develop greater independence and a proactive attitude in their TAs. Armed with questions and ideas and information, delegates will be well-placed to influence and inform 'What next?' to shape the practice and maximise the role of TAs in their schools.

By the end of the course participants will:-

- be conversant with current thinking and research based evidence, around maximising the impact of TAs
- be able to put this thinking into reviewing current provision and identifying where development is required
- have identified opportunities to develop independence and a proactive approach in their school's TAs
- have put together a plan of action for maximising the impact of TAs.
